

THE HUNA PATH TO SUCCESS AND PROSPERITY

Guidelines

From Hawaii

1. "Ukuli'i ka pua, ho'onaona i ka mau'u" (Tiny is the flower, yet it sweetens the grass/Your experience of the world is influenced by your thoughts and feelings).
2. "'A'ohe inoa komo 'ole o ka 'ai" (No name prevents food from entering the mouth/The thoughts of others cannot control your behavior).
3. "No'ono'o ke ali'i, ehu ka ukali" (Thought is the chief, activity the follower/Actions follow thoughts).
4. "Noho ka mana i keia manawa" (Power resides in this moment).
5. "Ke aloha, ke alo, ke oha, ka ha" (Love is being in the presence of someone or something while feeling good and sharing the feeling).
6. "Mai ka po mai ka mana" (Power comes from within).
7. "Ana 'oia i ka hopena" (Truth is measured by results).
8. "Ku'ai aku, ku'ai mai" (Buying and selling/Money is another form of barter).
9. "Ko koa uka, ko koa kai" (Those of the upland, those of the shore/Share so that everyone's needs are met).
10. "Ohi ka manu o ke ao" (The fishing bird reaps its harvest daily/Persistent action produces results).
11. "'A'ohe wawae o ka i'a; o 'oe ka mea wawae, ki'i mai" (A fish has no feet; you who have feet must come and get what you want/Thoughts must be reinforced by action).
12. "'Ala ke kai o ka 'anae" (Fragrant is the soup of a big mullet/A prosperous person attracts others).
13. "I kani no ka 'alae i ka wai" (A mudhen calls out because it has water/A prosperous person speaks with authority).
14. "Aia ke ola i kahiki" (Life is in Kahiki/Success comes from the inner world).
15. "Ana'ole, ke ao, ka po" (There are no limits to the outer world or the inner world).
16. "Pipi ka wahie, ho'onui ka pulupulu" (If the firewood burns slowly, add more kindling/If success is slow, increase the energy).
17. "Maka'ala ke kanaka kahea manu" (A man who calls birds should always be alert/Be prepared for opportunity).
18. "O ka pono ke hana 'ia a iho mai na lani" (Do good until the heavens come down to you/Blessings come to those who persist in doing good).
19. "'Eu kolea i kona puapua; 'eu ke kanaka i kona hanu" (A plover moves by means of its tail, a man moves by means of his breath/Your power to act comes from yourself).
20. "Ho'onohonoho i Waineki kauhale o Limaloa" (Well-arranged in the village of Waineki are the houses of Limaloa/Plans change)

Hawaiian Success and Prosperity chants:

1. "Hele ka wai, hele ka 'ala, wali ka 'ulu. Amama, ua noa." (The water flows, the pounder works, the breadfruit is smooth/Wealth comes, money comes, increase is easy. So be it, limitation is over)
2. Laka and Laka, the Hawaiian angels.
 - a) "E Laka kane e...e laka i ka mana, e laka i ka loa'a, e laka i ka waiwai" (O Laka the male... attract power, attract success, attract wealth). Amama, ua noa.
 - b) "E Laka wahine e...e laka i ke aloha, e laka i na hoa, e laka i ka laule'a" (O Laka the female... attract love, attract friends, attract peace). Amama, ua noa.

1. "Success is getting what you want, enjoying it, and sharing the benefits. Prosperity is having enough to share. From then on it's just a matter of degree."
2. "The process of succeeding and prospering is very simple: do something, get a reaction, do something else."

15. "When we feel powerless, we seek power; when we feel loveless, we seek love. When we feel powerful, we simply act; when we feel loved, we simply love."
16. "There is a basic human urge to solve puzzles and problems, and when there aren't enough around we make them up."
17. "Success and prosperity are states of feeling, and you can create those states regardless of external circumstances."
